**Information for Parents and Carers**

Streatham Wells School aims to provide a safe and enjoyable experience for every child. There are some children, for a variety of reasons, whose image cannot be shared on any social media platforms. We would like to allow parents/carers to take photos of assemblies/events etc but need your help.

- We are able to allow photographs to be taken in assembly and concerts/events if we have your agreement not to share any pictures of children, other than your own, on social media (Facebook, Twitter, Snapchat, Instagram etc)
- We will take all steps to ensure images of children are used solely for the purposes they are intended. If you become aware that images are being used inappropriately you should inform the school immediately.
- Do not take or share photographs, video or other images of children and young people without the consent of the children involved and their parents or carers. This agreement fits with our overarching online safety policy.

Parents/carers want to take general photos of events taking place and I am sure you will appreciate the issues surrounding not sharing photographs on social media.

We would like all parents/carers to agree to photographs/filming of events – class assemblies, Christmas concert etc.
